Program

1) Georg Friedrich Händel (1685-1759) "Concerto Grosso" Op.6-7

The concerto grosso is a style of baroque music in which several soloists concert with string orchestra and basso continuo. Händel composed about 30 concerti grossi. They have the rich variety in the number of movements and instruments, and give us unique musical contents combining the various styles of dance music, fugue, and so on.

2) Carl Philipp Emanuel Bach (1714-1788) "Symphony for String Orchestra" Wq.182 No.4

The composer is the second son of Johann Sebastian Bach and Maria Barbara. He was educated in clavier and music composition by his father. After the graduation of the University of Leipzig, he served Crown Prince Frederick of Prussia, the future Frederick the Great in Berlin. His personality enabled to open the sensitive style, a herald of the Romantic music at the time of transition between baroque style and classical style.

1st movement Allegro, ma non troppo 2nd movement Largo ed innocentemente

3rd movement Allegro assai

3) Charles Gounod (1879-1936) "Ave Maria"

Gounod is a French composer, best known for his Ave Maria. The piece consists of a melody that he superimposed over a slightly modified version of the Prelude from J. S. Bach's "The Well-tempered(平均律)Clavier Book I" published in 1722.

4) John Rutter (1945-) "Suite for Strings"

Rutter is an English composer of the late 20th century. The piece is full of the pleasant music and clear chords from the keynote of the songs, with pop, honest and friendly melodies. The piece consists of 4 movements, all of which are based on the folk songs inherited in Ireland and Scotland, but it has a modern arrangement.

1st movement Vivace "A-Roving"

2nd movement Allegretto comodo e grazioso "I have a bonnet trimmed with blue"

3rd movement Andante espressivo "O, Waly Waly"

4th movement Presto "Dashing away with the smoothing iron"
